說明：

- 一、依據澳洲反傾銷委員會(ADC)本(109)年6月15日致本組信函辦理。
- 二、前揭信函略以，澳洲反傾銷委員會頃接獲澳澳洲業者之申請有關對我出口至澳洲寬度等於或大於600毫米(mm)鍍鋁鋅合金鋼扁軋製品(aluminium zinc coated steel)課徵反傾銷稅案，適用產品稅則及統計代碼包括：7210.61.00(60、61與61)以及7225.99.00(39)。該會刻就申請書內容進行評估，俾作為發布反傾銷措施之依據，並稱依據「WTO反傾銷協定」第5.5條規定，該委員會在決定展開反傾銷調查前，將避免對外公開本案申請書，另依據澳洲法規，除非旨案申請人向該會提出進一步資訊，否則該會須在本年6月29日前做出是否對本案展開調查之決定。倘該會決定啟動調查，將儘速通知本組並提供非機密版之申請書

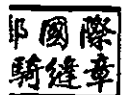

**APPLICATION FOR THE IMPOSITION OF DUMPING DUTY IN RESPECT OF  
ALUMINIUM ZINC COATED STEEL EXPORTED TO AUSTRALIA FROM  
TAIWAN**

I am writing to notify you that the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) has received a properly documented application requesting the publication of a dumping duty notice in respect of exports of **aluminium zinc coated steel having width equal to or greater than to 600 mm** exported to Australia from Taiwan. The goods are classified to the following tariff classifications and statistical codes:

- 7210.61.00 statistical codes 60, 61 and 62;
- 7225.99.00 statistical code 39.

The Commission is currently assessing the matters raised in the application to determine if the application appears to establish reasonable grounds for the publication of a dumping duty notice. Pursuant to Article 5.5 of the World Trade Organization *Anti-Dumping Agreement*, the Commission is avoiding any publicising of the application.

Australian legislation requires that a decision on whether to proceed with an investigation must be made on or before 29 June 2020, unless extended as a result of further information being provided to the Commission by the applicant. I will inform you of the outcome of the Commission consideration of the application as early as possible.

Should a decision be made to initiate the investigation, you will be provided with a copy of the non-confidential version of the application.
