一、依據澳洲反傾銷委員會(Anti-Dumping Commission, ADC)本(109)年7月24日2020/83號公告辦理，本組本年6月15日澳經發字第1090000382號函諒察。

二、前揭澳洲反傾銷委員會(ADC)公告要點如次：

(一)澳洲反傾銷委員會於上年10月25日公告展開「對自中國大陸、韓國、馬來西亞與臺灣進口中空結構型鋼(hollow structural sections)反傾銷措施檢討案」，本案涉及產品之稅則號列：7306.30.00、7306.50.00、7306.61.00、7306.69.00及7306.90.00。

(二)本案原訂於本年2月12日完成基礎事實報告(Statement of Essential Facts, SEF)，並於本年3月28日前向澳洲產業、科學暨技術部長陳報最終報告(final report)

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及建議，澳洲反傾銷委員會業於本年3月3日、5月11日及6月12日分別以2020/023號、2020/47及2020/59號公告三度展延前揭基礎事實報告與最終報告之公布日期在卷。由於本案相關分析與基礎事實報告準備工作延誤，該委員會決定第四次展延於本年10月16日前完成本案基礎事實報告並訂於本年11月30日前向澳洲產業、科學暨技術部長陳報最終報告及建議。

ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2020/83

**Hollow structural sections exported from
the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea,
Malaysia, Taiwan and the Kingdom of Thailand**

**Extension of time granted to issue
the Statement of Essential Facts and the Final Report
in relation to a Review of Anti-Dumping Measures No. 529**

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 25 October 2019, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) published a notice announcing the initiation of a review of the anti-dumping measures (the review) applying to certain hollow structural sections (the goods) exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China (China), the Republic of Korea (Korea), Malaysia, Taiwan and the Kingdom of Thailand (Thailand). A full description of the goods and the current anti-dumping measures is available in that notice, Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2019/132 (initiation notice).

The Commissioner subsequently extended the review to include consideration of the revocation of the measures as they apply to Kukje Steel Co., Ltd (Kukje), an exporter of the goods from Korea (ADN No. 2019/155 refers). These notices are available on the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) website at www.adcommission.gov.au.

The initiation notice advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) would be placed on the public record on or before 12 February 2020. The initiation notice also advised that a recommendation to the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology (the Minister) would be made in a final report on or before 28 March 2020.

I have previously been granted extensions of time to publish the SEF and provide the final report and recommendations to the Minister.¹ As a result of further delays in completing the Commission's analysis and preparation of the SEF, I, Paul Sexton, General Manager, Investigations of the Anti-Dumping Commission, requested an additional extension of the deadline for the Commissioner to publish the SEF and provide his final report and recommendation to the Minister.²

PUBLIC RECORD

The Commissioner has, under section 269ZHI(3) of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline to publish the SEF, and provide his final report and recommendation.³ The SEF will now be placed on the public record on or before **16 October 2020**.

Interested parties are invited to make submissions to the Commissioner in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Minister will now be made in a report due on or before **30 November 2020**.
