

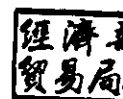

說明：

- 一、依據澳洲反傾銷委員會(ADC)本(110)年5月6日第2021/059號公告辦理，本組本年1月15日澳經發字第1100000063號函諒察。
- 二、前揭澳洲反傾銷委員會(ADC)公告要點如次：
 - (一)澳洲反傾銷委員會主委於本年1月15日決定，對自臺灣進口鍍鋅鋼品反傾銷措施展開期中檢討，本次檢討僅檢視我業者燁輝企業股份有限公司。本涉案產品稅號：7210.49.00、7212.30.00、7225.92.00及7226.99.00。自臺灣進口之旨揭產品係指表面鍍鋅，寬度小於、等於或大於600毫米之鐵與非合金鋼捲；以及表面鍍鋅，寬度小於、等於或大於600毫米含合金之鐵或鋼捲。
 - (二)本案原訂於2021年5月5日前完成本案之基礎事實報告(Statement of Essential Facts, SEF)，並訂於2021年6

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月19日前向澳洲產業、科學暨技術部長陳報建議與最終報告(final report)。

(三)鑒於該委員會刻正處理大量案件，決定依據1901年澳洲關務法(Customs Act 1901)之相關規定，展延本案之SEF以及最終報告與建議(final report)之公布日期。

(四)本案將展延於2021年9月2日前完成SEF，並訂於同年10月18日前向澳洲產業、科學暨技術部長陳報建議與最終報告。

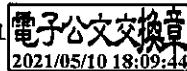

**Extension of time granted to issue the
Statement of Essential Facts and the Final Report
in relation to Review of Anti-Dumping Measures No. 570**

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 15 January 2021, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (Commissioner) published a notice announcing the initiation of a review of anti-dumping measures, in the form of a dumping duty notice, in respect of zinc coated (galvanised) steel (the goods) exported to Australia from Taiwan as they affect Yieh Phui Enterprise Co., Ltd, an exporter of the goods.

A full description of the goods is available in that notice, Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2021/002 (initiation notice). The initiation notice is available on the Anti-Dumping Commission's (Commission) website at www.adcommission.gov.au.

The initiation notice advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) would be placed on the public record on or before 5 May 2021. The initiation notice also advised that a recommendation to the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology would be made in a final report on or before 19 June 2021.

Due to the current high workload of the Anti-Dumping Commission, I, Justin Wickes, Acting General Manager, Anti-Dumping Commission, requested an extension of the deadline for the Commissioner to publish the SEF and provide his final report and recommendation to the Minister.¹

The Commissioner has, under section 269ZHI(3) of the *Customs Act 1901*,² extended the deadline to publish the SEF, and provide his final report and recommendation.

¹ On 15 December 2016, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission delegated his powers and functions under section 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901* to the General Managers of the Anti-Dumping Commission. See Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2017/10 on the Commission's website for further information.

² On 19 January 2017, the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science delegated the powers and functions of the Minister under section 269ZHI of the Act to the Commissioner. See Anti-Dumping Notice 2017/10 for further information.

The SEF will now be placed on the public record on or before **2 September 2021**. Interested parties are invited to make submissions to the Commissioner in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record.

A recommendation to the Minister will now be made in a report due on or before **18 October 2021**.
