主旨：有關澳洲反傾銷委員會公告「自我國、西班牙、印尼與希臘進口強化鋼條反傾銷措施即將屆期」事，請查照。

說明：

一、依據澳洲反傾銷委員會(ADC)本(111)年1月7日2022/005號公告辦理。

二、前揭公告要點如次：

(一)查澳洲自2018年3月7日起針對旨揭自我國進口之熱軋鋼捲(Hot Rolled Coil Steel)課徵反傾銷稅(註:1.我商為源鋼企業《Power Steel Co., Ltd.》2.涉案產品項目包括HS Code 7213.10.00、7214.20.00、7227.90.10、7227.90.90、7228.30.10、7228.30.90及7228.60.10)。該措施即將於2023年3月7日屆期。有意申請延續該等措施之利害關係人(註：本案申請廠商及代表全體或部分澳洲類似產品產業公協會之代表)應於2022年3月8日前向該委員會提出申請。ADC俟接獲申請展延案，將依申請人提供之證據決定駁回或依規定程序立案展開調查，並於155

日內完成調查再向產業、能源暨減排部長提出建議報告，倘無接獲相關展延申請，前揭反傾銷相關措施將自2023年3月7日起不再適用。

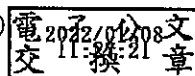

ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO 2022/005

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

Steel Reinforcing Bar

**Exported from Greece, the Republic of Indonesia,
Spain (Nervacero S.A), Taiwan (Power Steel Co. Ltd)
and the Kingdom of Thailand**

Expiry of anti-dumping measures

Notice under subsection 269ZHB(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (Cth)

I, Dr Bradley Armstrong PSM, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner), in accordance with subsection 269ZHB(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act),¹ advise that the anti-dumping measures on steel reinforcing bar, exported to Australia from Greece, the Republic of Indonesia (Indonesia), Spain (by Nervacero S.A), Taiwan (by Power Steel Co. Ltd), and the Kingdom of Thailand (Thailand) are due to expire.

The anti-dumping measures were initially imposed by public notice on 7 March 2018, by the then Assistant Minister for Science, Jobs and Innovation and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Jobs and Innovation, Zed Seselja, following the consideration of *Anti-Dumping Commission Final Report No 418*. The anti-dumping measures consist of a dumping duty notice in relation to the goods exported to Australia from Greece, Indonesia, Spain (by Nervacero S.A), Taiwan (by Power Steel Co. Ltd), and Thailand.²

The dumping duty notice is due to expire on 7 March 2023.

Those persons specified in subsection 269ZHB(1)(b) of the Act are invited to apply for a continuation of the measures. The application must be in writing, be in the form I have approved for the purposes of section 269ZHC, contain such information that the form requires, be signed in the manner indicated in the form, and be lodged in the manner approved under section 269SMS. Applications must be lodged by **8 March 2022**.

The application must provide evidence addressing whether there appears to be reasonable grounds for asserting that the expiration of the anti-dumping measures to which the application relates might lead, or might be likely to lead, to a continuation of, or a recurrence of, the material injury that the measures are intended to prevent.

² Anti-Dumping Notice No 2018/10. The dumping duty notice does not apply to exports from Indonesia by PT Ispat Panca Putera and PT Putra Baja Deli.

If an application is received that complies with the prescribed requirements and I decide not to reject that application, I will publish a notice on the Anti-Dumping Commission's website indicating that it is proposed to inquire whether continuation of the measures is justified. I will undertake an inquiry and report my recommendation to the Minister within 155 days of publication of the notice advising the commencement of the inquiry (or such longer period as may be allowed in accordance with section 269ZHI of the Act).

If no application is received within the period specified above, the anti-dumping measures applying to steel reinforcing bar, exported to Australia from Greece, Indonesia, Spain (by Nervacero S.A), Taiwan (by Power Steel Co. Ltd), and Thailand will expire on 7 March 2023. Therefore, on and from 8 March 2023 anti-dumping measures would no longer apply.
