Final Determinations in the Antidumping Duty Investigations

of Tin Mill Products from Eight Trading Partners and the Final Determination in the Countervailing Duty Investigation of Tin Mill Products from the People's Republic of China

On January 5, 2024, Commerce announced the final determinations in the antidumping duty (AD) investigations of tin mill products from Canada, the People's Republic of China (China), Germany, the Republic of Korea (Korea), the Netherlands, Taiwan, the Republic of Turkey (Turkey), and the United Kingdom. Commerce also announced the final determination in the accompanying countervailing duty (CVD) investigation of tin mill products from China.
