Dear Henry Chih-hung Liu:

The Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) has today concluded a re-investigation pursuant to the *Special Import Measures Act* (SIMA), of the normal values and export prices of certain hot-rolled carbon steel heavy plate and high-strength low-alloy steel heavy plate from the Separate Customs Territory of Taiwan, Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu (Chinese Taipei) and the Federal Republic of Germany.

The re-investigation is part of the CBSA's enforcement of the Canadian International Trade Tribunal's injury finding issued on February 5, 2021.
