Dear Henry Chih-hung Liu:

On November 30, 2023, you were notified that a re-investigation was initiated to update the normal values and export prices of certain carbon steel fasteners (fasteners) originating in or exported from the People's Republic of China (China) and the Separate Customs Territory of Taiwan, Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu (Chinese Taipei), and the amounts of subsidy of certain fasteners originating in or exported from China.

The re-investigation has been extended by seven days due to the complexity and novelty of the issues presented by the re-investigation. The re-investigation will now conclude by May 30, 2024.

The revised schedule is attached for your reference. Please note the revised date for the closing of the record as well as the revised dates for when case arguments and reply submissions are due.
