

Commerce Initiates Antidumping Investigations of Dioctyl Terephthalate (DOTP) from Malaysia, Poland, Taiwan, and Türkiye

On April 16, 2024, the U.S. Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced the initiation of antidumping duty (AD) investigations of dioctyl terephthalate (DOTP) from Malaysia, Poland, Taiwan, and Türkiye.
