Subject: Anti-dumping proceeding concerning imports of Acrylonitrile-Butadiene-Styrene (ABS) Resin originating, inter alia, in Taiwanan

Dear Sirs,

We refer to the letter of 19 December 2024 concerning the initiation of an anti-dumping proceeding on imports of Acrylonitrile-Butadiene-Styrene (ABS) Resins, originating, *inter alia*, in Taiwan.

We would like to inform you that three exporting producers in Taiwan provided the information requested in the Notice of Initiation.

Pursuant to Article 17 of the basic Regulation, the selection of the sample is normally based on the largest representative volume of exports to the Union during the investigation period which can reasonably be investigated within the time available.

However, for Taiwan, the relationships between the companies in question were also taken into account¹. As a result, in the case of Taiwan, the investigation will cover the total export volume to the Union during the investigation period and all three cooperating Taiwanese exporting producers, which the Commission at this stage treats as two groups of related companies.

The Commission will examine the following companies:
