## **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE No 2025/008**

### **Review of Measures No 642 in relation to Hot Rolled Structural Steel Sections**

**Exported to Australia from Japan, The Republic of Korea,  
Taiwan (except by Feng Hsin Steel Co Ltd,  
T S Steel Co., Ltd and Tung Ho Steel Enterprise  
Corporation) and The Kingdom of Thailand**

### **Extension of time granted to issue the Final Report**

*Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB*

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) has extended the due date to provide the final report and recommendation to the Minister about the above case.<sup>1</sup>

#### **New milestone dates**

**Final Report** – A recommendation to the Minister will be made in a final report which is now due on, or before, **31 March 2025**.

The previous due date for the final report was 10 February 2024.
