## FINAL DETERMINATION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE (SUNSET) REVIEW OF ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON IMPORTS OF COLD ROLLED COILS OF IRON OR NON-ALLOY STEEL, OF WIDTH MORE THAN 1,300MM ORIGINATING OR EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA, THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA, JAPAN AND THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIET NAM

On 24 December 2024, the Government of Malaysia (Government) initiated an administrative (sunset) review on the anti-dumping (AD) duties imposed on imports of cold rolled coils (CRC) of iron or non-alloy steel, of width more than 1,300mm excluding tin mill black plate and subject merchandise imported for the purposes of automotive and finwall for transformer end usage (subject merchandise) originating or exported from the People's Republic of China (PRC), the Republic of Korea (ROK), Japan and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam (Viet Nam). The administrative (sunset) review was initiated based on an application filed by Mycron Steel CRC Sdn. Bhd. on behalf of the domestic industry.

Pursuant to subsection 28(6) of the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Act 1993 (Act), the administrative (sunset) review was carried out by the Government to determine whether the expiry of AD duties would likely lead to a continuation or recurrence of dumping and injury to the domestic industry.

In accordance with the provisions of the Act and the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Regulations 1994 (Regulations), the Government has completed the administrative (sunset) review and made an affirmative final determination to continue the imposition of AD duties on imports of the subject merchandise originating or exported from PRC and Japan, as follows:

The Royal Malaysian Customs Department shall enforce the collection of the AD duties on the imports of the subject merchandise for a period of five (5) years, effective from 23 June 2025 to 22 June 2030.

In addition to that, the Government has made a negative final determination to terminate the imposition of AD duties and the investigations on the imports of the subject merchandise originating or exported from ROK and Viet Nam, effective from 23 June 2025.
