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**NOTIFICATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 12.1(C)
OF THE AGREEMENT ON SAFEGUARDS**

INDONESIA

*Articles of Apparel and Clothing Accessories**Supplement*

The following communication, dated and received on 3 October 2025, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Indonesia.

Pursuant to Article 12 of the WTO Agreement on Safeguards, the Republic of Indonesia hereby wishes to notify the Committee on Safeguards that its competent authority terminated the extension of the safeguard measures proceeding concerning to prevent or remedy serious injury and that the industry is adjusting of Apparel and Clothing Accessories without adopting a safeguard measure.

1. The product subject to investigation

Articles of Apparel and Clothing Accessories under 131 8-digit Harmonized System (HS.) Code according to Indonesia Customs Tariff Book 2022.

2. The date of initiation of safeguard investigation

The investigation regarding the extension of the safeguard measures initiated on 7 November 2024.

3. The WTO document containing the notification of initiation

4. The date on which the investigation was terminated

The investigation was terminated on 29 September 2025.

5. The reason for termination

Based on the findings of the investigation, the evidence is not adequate to justify that the safeguard measure remains necessary to prevent serious injury and that the domestic industry was undertaking structural adjustment in response to increased imports during the period of investigation. Accordingly, the Investigating Authority decided to terminate the investigation pursuant to Article 7.2 of the Agreement on Safeguards.

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KPPI Hentikan Penyelidikan Perpanjangan *Safeguard Measure* Impor Pakaian dan Aksesori Pakaian

Jakarta, 1 Oktober 2025 – Komite Pengamanan Perdagangan Indonesia (KPPI) menghentikan penyelidikan perpanjangan tindakan pengamanan perdagangan (*safeguard measure*) terhadap impor barang pakaian dan aksesori pakaian pada Senin (29/9). Komoditas tersebut termasuk ke dalam 131 nomor Harmonized System (HS) 8 digit sesuai dengan Buku Tarif Kepabeanan Indonesia (BTKI) Tahun 2022.

“Keputusan penghentian ini didasarkan pada hasil penyelidikan perpanjangan yang dilakukan KPPI sepanjang 2021—2024. Hasil tersebut menunjukkan tidak tersedia bukti yang cukup untuk memenuhi persyaratan perpanjangan Tindakan Pengamanan Perdagangan,” ungkap Ketua KPPI Julia Gustaria Silalahi pada Rabu (1/10) di Jakarta.

Keputusan penghentian perpanjangan tersebut telah sesuai dengan Artikel 7.1 *Agreement on Safeguards* dan Peraturan Pemerintah Nomor 34 Tahun 2011 tentang Tindakan Antidumping, Tindakan Imbalan, dan Tindakan Pengamanan Perdagangan Pasal 88 Ayat (3). Dalam aturan ini, perpanjangan tindakan pengamanan dapat dilakukan apabila pemohon memenuhi persyaratan.

Lebih lanjut, Julia menjelaskan bahwa barang yang termasuk ke dalam penghentian penyelidikan perpanjangan terbagi atas tujuh segmen. Segmen tersebut meliputi pakaian kasual bagian atas, pakaian formal bagian atas, pakaian bagian bawah, setelan ansambel dan gaun, pakaian luar (*outerwear*), pakaian bayi, serta aksesori kepala (*headwear*) dan leher (*neckwear*).

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KPPI Halts Investigation into *Safeguard Measure* Extension Import of Clothing and Clothing Accessories

Jakarta, October 1, 2025 – The Indonesian Trade Safeguards Committee (KPPI) on Monday (September 29) suspended its investigation into the extension of safeguard measures *on* imported clothing and clothing accessories. These commodities are included in the 131 8-digit Harmonized System (HS) numbers listed in the 2022 Indonesian Customs Tariff Book (BTKI).

"This decision to terminate the agreement is based on the results of the KPPI's extension investigation conducted between 2021 and 2024. These findings indicate insufficient evidence to meet the requirements for extending the Trade Safeguard Measures," said KPPI Chairwoman Julia Gustaria Silalahi on Wednesday (October 1) in Jakarta.

The decision to stop the extension is in accordance with Article 7.1 of *the Agreement on Safeguards* and Government Regulation Number 34 of 2011 concerning Antidumping Measures, Countervailing Measures, and Trade Safeguard Measures, Article 88 Paragraph (3). In this regulation, the extension of safeguard measures can be carried out if the applicant meets the requirements.

Furthermore, Julia explained that the items included in the termination of the investigation
The extension is divided into seven segments. These segments include casual tops, formal tops, bottoms, ensembles and dresses, outerwear , babywear, and headwear *and* neckwear .

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
