WITH NO SAFEGUARD MEASURE IMPOSED**

*Corrugating medium*

The following communication, dated and received on 1 April 2026, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of the Philippines.

**1. Provide the precise description of the product involved**

Corrugating medium.

Corrugating medium classified under ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 4805.19.10, 4805.19.90 and 4805.12.00.

HS code(s): 4805.19.10, 4805.19.90, 4805.12.00.

**3. Specify the date on which the investigation was terminated**

26 March 2026.

**4. Identify the reason(s) for termination (e.g. petition withdrawn; negative determination of injury; negative determination of causation, etc.)**

Based on the Philippine Tariff Commission's (Commission) findings that the available industrywide information was insufficient to make a positive determination of serious injury or threat thereof to the domestic industry, hence, the causal relationship between increased imports of recycled corrugating medium and serious injury or threat thereof to the domestic industry cannot be established. Consequently, the Commission concluded its formal investigation and recommended that no definitive general safeguard measure be imposed on importations of the corrugating medium subject of this investigation.

**5. Provide the reference for the published notice of termination (name of notifying Member's official journal, date and page number at which notice appeared in the journal)**

The said Order was published today, 01 April 2026 in two (2) newspapers of general circulation – Manila Standard and Business Mirror.
