APPLICATION FOR A DUMPING DUTY NOTICE IN RESPECT OF STEEL FLAT BARS EXPORTED TO AUSTRALIA FROM TAIWAN

I am writing to notify you that the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) has received a properly documented application requesting the publication of a dumping duty notice in respect of exports of Steel Flat Bars exported to Australia from Taiwan. The goods are described by the applicant as being classified to tariff classification 7214.91.00.

The Commission is currently assessing the matters raised in the application to determine if the application appears to establish reasonable grounds for the publication of a dumping duty notice. Pursuant to Article 5.5 of the WTO *Anti-Dumping Agreement*, the Commission is avoiding any publicising of the application.

Australian legislation requires that a decision on whether to proceed with an investigation must be made on or before 25 June 2026. I will inform you of the outcome of the Commission's consideration of the application as early as possible.

Should a decision be made to initiate the investigation, you will be provided with a copy of the non-confidential version of the application.
