**NOTIFICATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 12.1(C)
OF THE AGREEMENT ON SAFEGUARDS**

Supplement

The following communication, dated and received on 11 June 2026, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Indonesia.

Pursuant to Article 12 of the WTO Agreement on Safeguards, the Republic of Indonesia hereby notifies the Committee on Safeguards that the safeguard investigation concerning the importation of evaporators of the roll-bond and fin type used in refrigerators, freezers, and other refrigerating or freezing equipment has been terminated without further extension of a safeguard measure.

1. The product subject to investigation

Evaporator in a type of roll-bond and fin that is part of refrigerators, freezers, and other refrigerating or freezing equipment under Harmonized System (HS.) Code: Ex. 8418.99.10.

2. The date of initiation

The investigation initiated on 7 April 2026.

3. The WTO document containing the notification of initiation

4. The date on which the investigation was terminated

The investigation has been terminated on 8 June 2026.

5. The reason for termination

Based on the results of the investigation, the Investigating Authority found that, during the period of application of the safeguard measure (2020–2025), the domestic industry recovered from the serious injury previously established, as evidenced by improvements in key performance indicators, including production volume, domestic sales volume, productivity, capacity utilization, and employment.

The Investigating Authority further found that the domestic industry's performance remained stable and profitable during the period 2023–2025, notwithstanding an increase in imports. In addition, the domestic industry had substantially completed its structural adjustment program, with an average implementation rate of 97.22%.

Considering the recovery and stable condition of the domestic industry, together with the substantial completion of its structural adjustment program, the investigating authority determined that the conditions required under Article 7.2 of the WTO Agreement on Safeguards for the extension of a safeguard measure were no longer met.

Accordingly, the Investigating Authority concluded that the continued application of the safeguard measure was no longer necessary to prevent or remedy serious injury and to facilitate adjustment of the domestic industry. Therefore, the safeguard measure will expire at the end of its current period of application and will not be extended.
